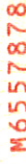


This passport contains a microchip which stores the same information as appears on the data page. The chip can be read electronically to confirm the identity of the bearer. This document complies with International Civil Aviation Organisation standards and incorporates security features to prevent illegal access to the information stored on the chip. See the centre page of the passport for further information.

lost or stolen passports provide criminals and terrorists with the opportunity to assume another identity, travel illegally and commit crimes. You must report the loss or theft of your passport without delay. A lost or stolen passport will be immediately and permanently cancelled. It must not be used again under any circumstances. Lost or stolen passport information is shared with other countries and use of a cancelled passport may result in denial of entry to overseas countries and disruption of travel plans.

To replace a lost or stolen passport, you will need to pay an additional fee on top of the normal application fee. In cases of multiple losses the replacement passport may be restricted in validity.

The Australian Passports Act 2005 imposes tough penalties on anyone using a cancelled passport. Your passport identifies you – protect it at all times.
