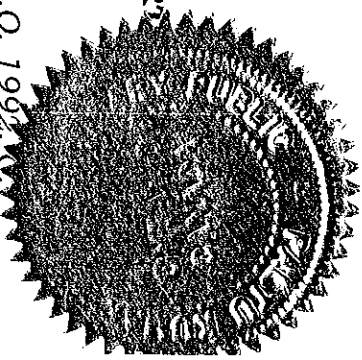


THIS CONTINUING POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR PROPERTY



MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SUBSTITUTE DECISIONS ACT, S.O. 1992, c. 6,
AS AMENDED BY THE ADVOCACY, CONSENT AND SUBSTITUTE DECISIONS
STATUTE LAW AMENDMENT ACT, 1996

1. **THIS POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR PROPERTY** is given by **Anit Mukhopadhyay** of the City of Mississauga, in the Province of Ontario.

2. **I APPOINT** my spouse, **Anuradha Mukhopadhyay**, of the City of Mississauga, in the Province of Ontario, to be my attorney for property in accordance with the *Substitute Decisions Act*, and to do my behalf anything that I could lawfully do in respect of my property if I were capable, except make a Will, subject to any conditions and restriction contained herein.

3. **IF THE ABOVE APPOINTED ATTORNEY** is not able to act because of death, incapacity or resignation, I appoint, my daughter Ankita Mukherjee, of the City of Kitchener, in the Province of Ontario, to act as my attorney for personal care pursuant to the *Substitute Decisions Act*. An Attorney is to be considered incapable of acting, as my attorney for personal care if a certificate of incapacity has been signed by an assessor that my attorney is incapable

4. **IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 7(1)** of the *Substitute Decisions Act*, I declared that this Power of Attorney is a Continuing Power of Attorney for property and the authority given may be exercised during my incapacity to manage property.

5. **THIS POWER OF ATTORNEY** is subject to the following conditions, restrictions and supplementary powers:

(a) I authorize my attorney(s) to exercise all powers in my name as I would lawfully be able to exercise had I legal capacity to exercise such powers, except make a Will.

(b) I authorize my attorney(s) to secure information on behalf of my Estate in respect of its dealings with any person, government, or institution.

(c) I expressly constitute my attorney(s) as my "legal representative(s)" for the purposes of the *Income Tax Act*.
