LOCATION REQUIREMENTS



To ensure proper ventilation for your refrigerator, allow for a 1/2" (1.25 cm) space on each side and at the top. Allow for 1" (2.54 cm) of space behind the refrigerator. If your refrigerator has an ice maker, make sure you leave some extra space at the back for the water line connections.

If you are installing your refrigerator next to a fixed wall, leave 2 1/2" (6.3 cm) minimum on the hinge side (some models require more) to allow for the door to swing open.

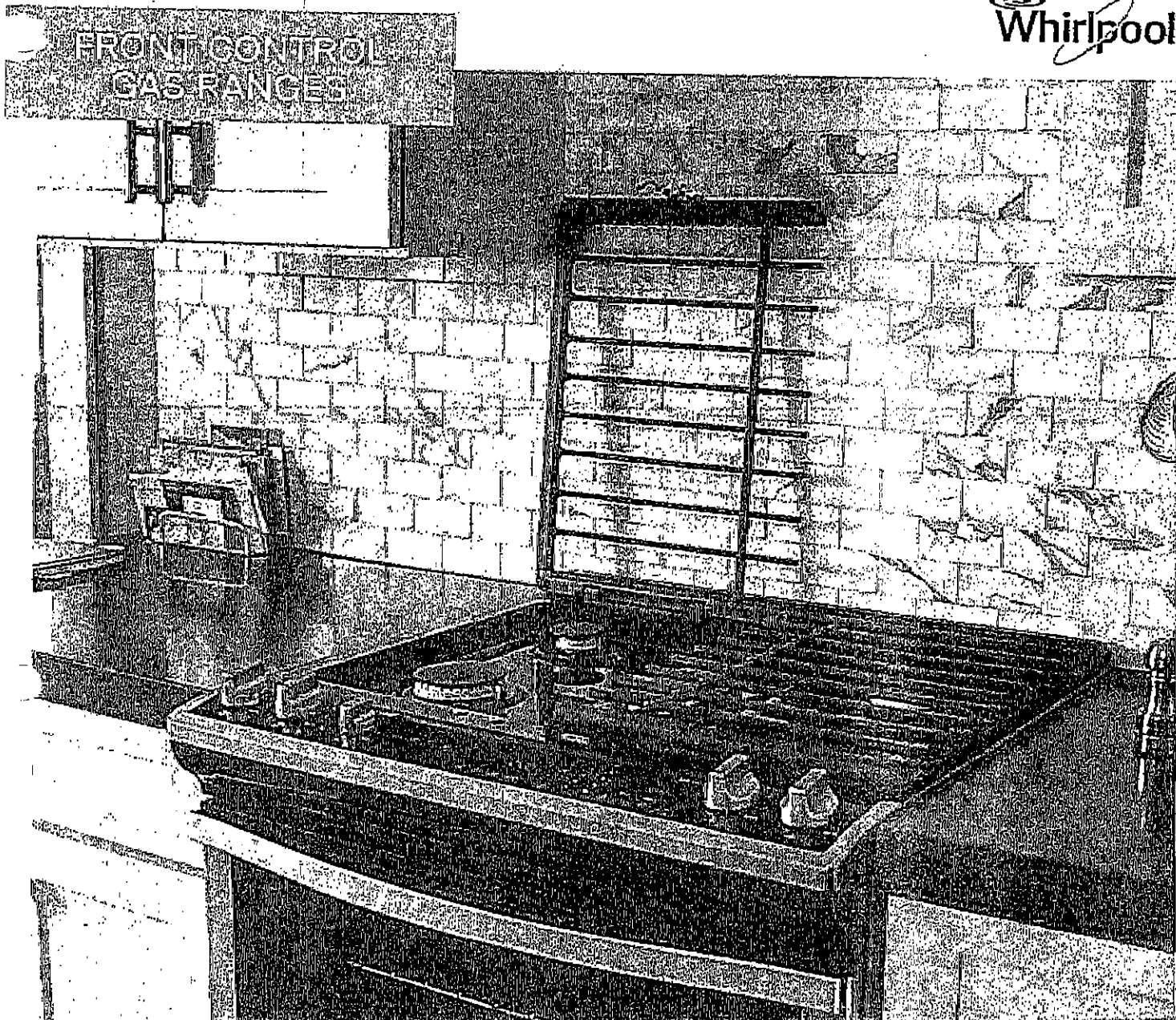

GAS SUPPLY REQUIREMENTS

Gas supply line:

- Provide a gas supply line of 3/4" (1.9 cm) rigid pipe to the range location. A smaller size pipe on longer runs may result in insufficient gas supply. With LP gas, piping or tubing size can be 1/2" (1.3 cm) minimum. Usually, LP gas suppliers determine the size and materials used in the system.

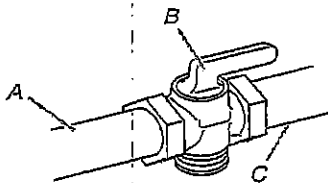
NOTE: Pipe-joint compounds that resist the action of LP gas must be used. Do not use TEFLON® tape.

Flexible metal appliance connector:

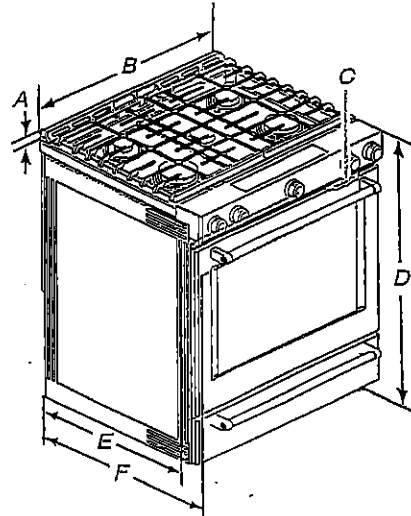

Electrical Requirements: 120-volt, 60-Hz, AC only, 15- or 20-amp. fused electrical supply. Copper wire only. A time delay fuse or circuit breaker and separate circuit is recommended.

If direct wiring dishwasher: Use flexible, armored, or nonmetallic, sheathed copper wire with grounding wire that meets the wiring requirements for your home and local codes and ordinances.

Use a UL listed or CSA approved conduit connector.

If connecting dishwasher with a power supply cord:

Use Power Supply Cord Kit (Part No. 4317824) marked for use with dishwashers. Follow the kit instructions for installing the power supply cord.

Power supply cord must plug into a grounded 3 prong, outlet, located in the cabinet next to the dishwasher opening. Outlet must meet all local codes and ordinances.

Water Supply Requirements: A hot water line with 20 to 120 psi (138 to 862 kPa) water pressure. Water temperature must be 120°F (49°C) water at dishwasher. Use 3/8" O.D. copper tubing with compression fitting or flexible braided water supply line (1/2" minimum plastic tubing is not recommended). Use a 90° elbow with 1/4"N.P.T. external pipe threads on one end. Do not solder within 6" (15.2 cm) from water inlet valve.

Drain Requirements: A new drain hose is supplied with your dishwasher. If this is not long enough, use a new drain hose with a maximum length of 12' (3.7 m) (Part No. 3385556) that meets all current AHAM/IAPMO test standards, is resistant to heat and detergent, and fits the 1" (2.5 cm) drain connector of the dishwasher.

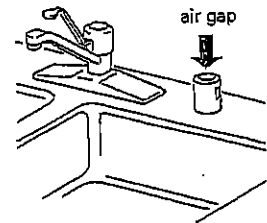
Make sure to connect the drain hose to waste tee or disposer inlet above drain trap in house plumbing and 20" (50.8 cm) minimum above the floor. It is recommended

that the drain hose either be looped up and securely fastened to the underside of the counter or be connected to an air gap.

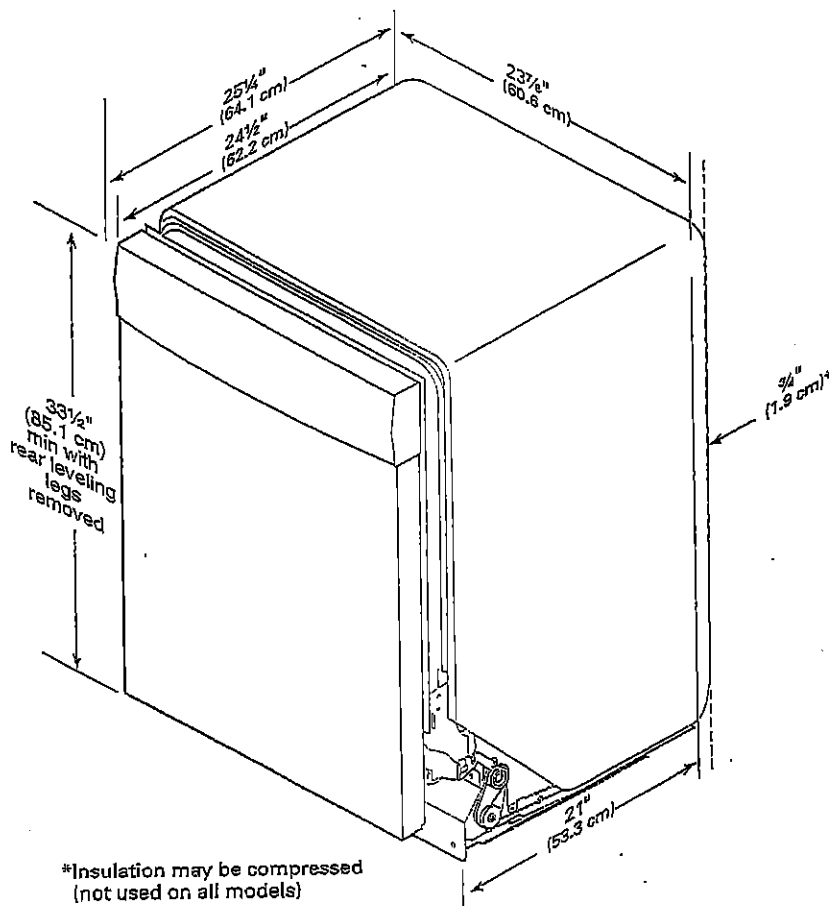
Make sure to use an air gap if the drain hose is connected to house plumbing lower than 20" (50.8 cm) above subfloor or floor.

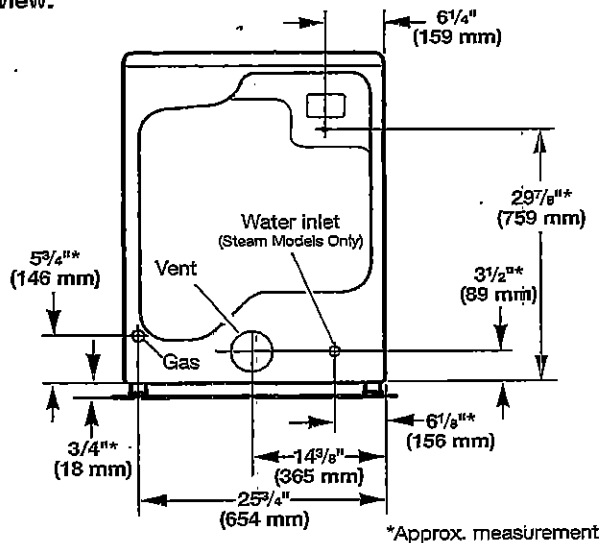

- A separate 15 or 20 amp circuit for a gas dryer or 30 amp circuit for an electric dryer.
- If using power supply cord, a grounded electrical outlet located within 2 ft. (610 mm) of either side of dryer. See "Electrical Requirements."
- Floor must support dryer weight of 200 lbs. (90.7 kg). Also consider weight of companion appliance.
- Cold water faucets located within 4 ft. (1.2 m) of the water fill valves, and water pressure of 20–120 psi (138–827 kPa). You may use your washer's water supply by purchasing the necessary parts noted in "Parts needed."
- Level floor with maximum slope of 1" (25 mm) under entire dryer. If slope is greater than 1" (25 mm), install Extended Dryer Feet Kit, Part Number, 279810. If not level, clothes may not tumble properly and automatic sensor cycles may not operate correctly.
- For garage installation, place dryer at least 18" (460 mm) above floor. If using a pedestal, you will need 18" (460 mm) to bottom of dryer.
- The dryer must not be installed or stored in an area where it will be exposed to water and/or weather.

IMPORTANT: Do not operate, install, or store dryer where it will be exposed to water, weather, or at temperatures below 40°F (4°C). Lower temperatures may cause dryer not to shut off at end of automatic sensor cycles, resulting in longer drying times.

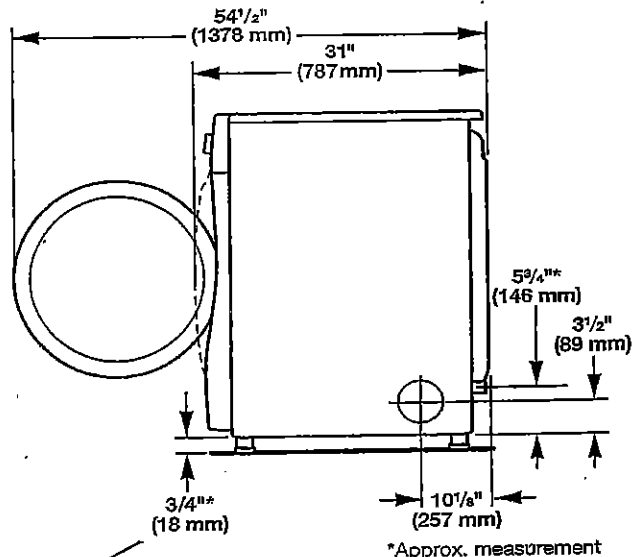

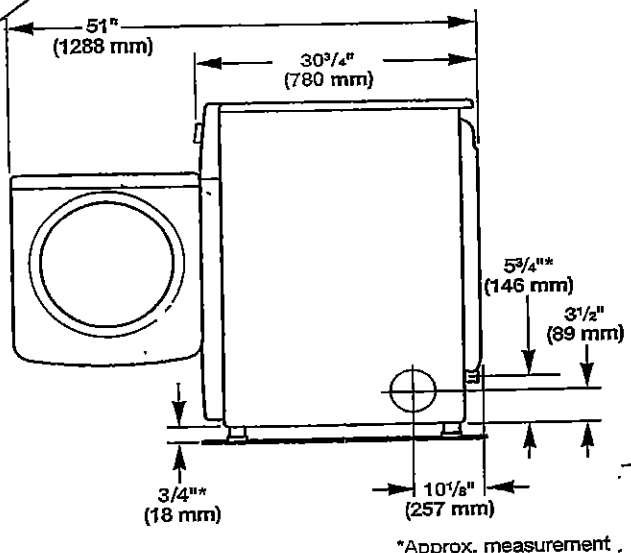
