1. Place level on the oven bottom, as indicated in one of the 2 figures below, depending on the size of the level. Check with the level side to side and front to back.



If range is not level, use a wrench or pliers to adjust leveling legs up or down until the range is level.

Electrical Requirements: 120-volt, 60-Hz, AC only. 15- or 20-amp, fused electrical supply. Copper wire only. A time delay fuse or circuit breaker and separate circuit is recommended.

If direct wiring dishwasher: Use flexible, armored,


instructions for installing the power supply cord. Power supply cord must plug into a grounded 3 prong, outlet, located in the cabinet next to the dishwasher opening. Outlet must meet all

local codes and ordinances.

Water Supply Requirements: A hot water line with 20 to 120 psi (138 to 862 kPa) water pressure. Water temperature must be 120°F (49°C) water at dishwasher. Use %" 0.D. copper tubing with compression fitting or flexible braided water supply line (½" minimum plastic tubing is not recommended). Use a 90°elbowlwith ¾"N.P.T. external pipe threads on one end. Do not solderwithin 6" (15.2 cm) from water inlet valve. from water inlet valve.

Drain Requirements: A new drain hose is supplied with your dishwasher. If this is not long enough, use a new drain hose with a maximum length of 12' (3.7 m) (Part No. 3385556) that meets all current AHAM/IAPMO test standards, is resistant to heat and detergent, and fits the 1" (2.5 cm) drain connector of the dishwasher.

Make sure to connect the drain hose to waste tee or disposer inlet above drain trap in house plumbing and 20" (50.8 cm) minimum above the floor. It is recommended




that the drain hose either be looped up and securely fastened to the underside of the counter or be connected to an air gap.


Make sure to use an air gap if the drain hose is connected to house plumbing lower than 20" (50.8 cm) above subfloor or floor.

Use 1/2" (1.3 cm) minimum I.D. drain line fittings. If required, the air gap should be installed in accordance with the air gap installation instructions. When connecting the air gap, a rubber hose (not provided) will be needed to connect to the waste tee or disposer inlet.




CABINET CUTOUT DIMENSIONS


- A water heater set to 120°F (49°C).
- A grounded electrical outlet located within 6 ft (1.8 m) of power cord on back of washer.
- Hot and cold water faucets located within 4 ft (1.2 m) of hot and cold water fill valves on washer, and water pressure of 20–100 psi (137.9–689.6 kPa).
- A level floor with maximum slope of 1" (25 mm) under entire washer. Installing on carpet or surfaces with foam backing is not recommended.
- Floor must support washer's total weight (with water and load) of 315 lbs (143 kgs).


IMPORTANT: Do not install! store, or operate washer where it will be exposed to weather or in temperatures below 32°F (0°C). Water remaining in washer after use may cause damage in low temperatures. See "Washer Care" in your Use and Care Guide for winterizing information.




Recessed area or closet installation (stacked washer and dryer):










Recessed area or closet installation:







Wall standpipe drain system



- Additional clearances might be required for wall, door, floor moldings, dryer venting, and gas line.
- Additional spacing should be considered on all sides of the dryer to reduce noise transfer.
- For closet installation with a door, minimum ventilation openings in the top and bottom of the door are required. Louvered doors with equivalent ventilation openings are acceptable.
- Companion appliance spacing should also be considered.

Recommended installation clearances (dryer only):



 $0\,^{\rm n}$ (0 mm) rear spacing is allowed for straight back venting only. For steam models only, inlet hose must not be kinked.

Mobile home - Additional installation requirements:

- A UL Listed strain relief.


You will need:

- A location allowing for proper exhaust installation. See "Venting Requirements."
- A separate 15 or 20 amp circuit for a gas dryer or 30 amp circuit for an electric dryer.
- If using power supply cord, a grounded electrical outlet located within 2 ft. (610 mm) of either side of dryer. See "Electrical Requirements."
- Floor must support dryer weight of 200 lbs. (90.7 kg). Also consider weight of companion appliance.
- Cold water faucets located within 4 ft. (1.2 m) of the water fill valves, and water pressure of 20–120 psi (138–827 kPa). You may use your washer's water supply by purchasing the necessary parts noted in "Parts needed."
- Level floor with maximum slope of 1" (25 mm) under entire dryer. If slope is greater than 1" (25 mm), install Extended Dryer Feet Kit, Part Number 279810. If not level, clothes may not tumble properly and automatic sensor cycles may not operate correctly.
- For garage installation, place dryer at least 18" (460 mm) above floor. If using a pedestal, you will need 18" (460 mm) to bottom of dryer.
- The dryer must not be installed or stored in an area where it will be exposed to water and/or weather.


