
- For indoor use only.
- For household use only. This hood is not to be used to exhaust explosive or dangerous fumes or materials.
- For your safety and for optimum performance, refer to the 'Installation Drawings' below for the
 distance required between the cooktop and the range hood taking into consideration the height
 of the ceiling. If the instructions for installation of the gas hob specify a greater distance, this has
 to be taken into account as well.
- The exhaust air must not be discharged into a chimney that is used for exhausting fumes from other appliances that burn gas or other fuels.
- Determine the exact location of the vent hood. Mark the location. Find the centerline of the cooktop. Use a level to draw a vertical straight pencil line on the wall.
- Plan the route for venting exhaust to the outdoors. Use the shortest and straightest duct route possible. Make sure the first duct runs is at least 12" before redirecting.
